





Additional Recommendations

- Connect food banks interested in mentoring food maximization groups with interested members in their area who could serve as mentors.
- Include Food Recovery as part of advocacy efforts.
- Develop coordination effort whereby individual cold storage companies can donate equipment.
- Sponsor interested food bank operations managers to participate in the Energy Efficiency program.
- Provide scholarships for interested individuals to audit WFLO Institute courses most relevant to their challenges.
- Create a presentation to educate customers about options to avoid food waste.
